Technical Rider – CLIFFSIGHT

Dear Promoter, dear Technician!

This is the technical rider for **Cliffsight**. We would like you to know that these are our "minimal-optimum requirements! If you are not able, especially for reasons of space, to provide us with one or another of those requirements, it is not necessarily the end of the world. However, in that case we would ask you to <u>get in touch with us soon</u>!

Usually we have somebody with us who knows the band's sound well. But this is in no way a substitute for a competent sound technician on location, who is familiar with the local circumstances and the specifications of the PA!

MONITORING:

It is massively helpful if every musician has his own monitor channel. Should that not be possible for some reason, please contact us about the distribution of monitor channels and cabinets at hand!

- **Channel 1: Center Vocals / Guitar:** Tim Cammerzell 2 Wedges min. 12/2" / 500W
- Channel 2: Stage right / house left Bass: Christopher Kautz 1 Wedge min. 12/2" / 500W
- Channel 3: Stage left / house right Guitar: Felix Topitsch 1 Wedge min. 12/2" / 500W

Channel 4: Drums: Adrian Schein

Drumfill min. 15" / 600W IMPORTANT: Adrian is left-handed and builds his set accordingly! The monitor has to be placed on his right side (Hihat)! The monitor should <u>not</u> be placed on the drum riser!

BACKLINE:

Cliffsight are playing with the following backline:

<u>Drums – Adrian Schein:</u> Mapex Orion Series 22" Kickdrum, 14" Snare, 16" Floortom, 13" Racktom, 14" Hihat, 20" Ride cymbal, 18" Crash cymbal <u>Bass – Christopher Kautz:</u> Ampeg 4x10" or Ampeg 8x10" with Orange AD 200 B Mk3 Vollröhre (200W) or Aguilar Tonehammer 500 Transistor (500W)

<u>Guitar – Felix Topitsch:</u> Hiwatt Halfstack 4x12" with Hiwatt Custom Tube-amp (100W)

<u>Guitar & Vocals – Tim Cammerzell:</u> Vox AC-30 C2 2x12" Tube-Combo (30W)

If the **backline is provided or shared** it is essential that the material is of the <u>same</u> <u>quality</u> at the minimum!

In this case, please get in touch with us about the equipment to prevent unpleasant surprises!

FOH:

The soundboard should have at least 16 channels.

We require at the minimum a reverb and a tap delay on two separate auxchannels!

Talkback is always helpful for communication with the band.

POWER:

The band needs 7 power supplies (230V) on stage according to the stageplot. They bring their own distribution – extension cords to the relevant positions should be provided!

The power supply on stage must be part of the "sound circuit"! A mixed circuit for sound and light usually brings unpleasant "humming"!

<u>PA:</u>

The PA should be appropriate for the venue and provide sufficient, low-distortion sound pressure at all places.

Cliffsight play loud and bass-heavy! We recommend tops with min. 12" and separate subs with two min. 18" cabinets for each side.

<u>LIGHT:</u>

Cliffsight likes to work with "silhouettes".

Mainly backlight, a rather dark general mood and fog / haze (DMX-controlled!) are always a good start.

<u>Frontlight:</u>

A red spot for center stage is welcome- Apart from that rather dark.

<u>Backlight:</u>

Primary colours / strong colours only please! Blue and Green, also Red. White "blinder effects" in the right parts are always a nice thing.

<u>NO</u> strobes please!

STAGE:

The stage should be at least 5x4m and 40cm high. The drum riser should be at least 2x2m and 20cm high.

The band likes to set up the guitar cabinets elevated. Cases or similar that can be provided would be a big help!

Safety on stage is absolutely necessary! Tim (Vocals) moves a lot – it is important that as few cables as possible are pulled across the stage resp. cables are taped or covered.
